Psalm 106 foretells the miracle of fish catching ("his wonders in the deep") that nearly broke the fishermen's nets, performed before the eyes of the fishermen themselves (the Apostles); fishermen are those that "do business in great waters".

The same psalm foretells the calming of the storm in the middle of the sea that caught the Ship with the Apostles in its roaring.

Psalm 106: "They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters; These men have seen the works of the Lord, and His wonders in the deep. He spake the word, and a stormy wind arose; and the waves thereof were lifted up. They mount up to the heavens, and they go down into the depths; their soul was melted away with evils. They were troubled, and they staggered as a drunken man; and all their wisdom was swallowed up. And they cried unto the Lord in their affliction, and He brought them out of their distresses. And He commanded the storm, and it was calmed into a breeze, and the waves thereof fell silent. And they were glad, because they were stilled; and He guided them to the haven of His will."
